- Supports digital inclusion projects-
- Supported device distribution to veterans in Western Maryland
- Funded through State's operating budget
- Eligible entities include ruralserving nonprofits, regional councils and community colleges

- Rural Maryland Prosperity Investment Fund
- Infrastructure component
- ► Must include 2 units of government
- Can only fund 25% of project
- Eligible entities: Nonprofits, units of local government, institutes of higher education and region councils


